Pacific Seacraft's New 40'

The Pacific Seacraft 40 is the newest model in the Pacific Seacraft line . Since 1976, Pacific Seacraft has built its reputation based upon the performance, strength of construction, classic beauty and hundreds of thousands of cumulative miles logged by the boats that it builds. The company has been twice chosen to the 'Fortune' magazine list of '100 products that America Makes Best'. Naval Architect, W.I.B. Crealock is world renown as a designer of safe and scakindly sailboats.

The moderately proportioned hull with the Crealock signature canoe stern is the envelope for a basically functional, but carefully crafted interior. Moderate beam and split appendage underbody combine to form an easily driven hull shape. The skeg hung rudder is protected to prevent damage to it or the propeller from grounding or debris. Two keels are available: the standard with a draft of 6'-0", and the Crealock-designed shoal draft bulb keel, both cast by [Mars Metal](#).

With forward and aft staterooms, the 40 provides comfortable accommodations for two cruising couples. On deck, bulwarks, tall stanchions, and high cockpit coamings complete the safety-in-design statement.
